

 - Hygiene Drive





Computer Science Elective

International School offers: Coding with Python (2 semesters), AP Computer Science Principles, and AP Computer Science

Students in their Junior and Senior years may elect to take Computer Science courses by dropping one of their following seven core classes:

- Junior year: Math or PE
- Senior year: Science, French or Art

Advance Science Offerings

•International typically rotates through the following advanced Science offerings: AP Biology, AP Chemistry, AP Physics 1, AP Physics 2, AP Environmental Science.

•For the last decade, IS has offered 6 sections of advanced science each year, alternating between 3 course offerings and 4 course offerings (5 offerings in 2019-20). The only course that has historically been offered each year is AP Physics 1.

•Student interest is surveyed as part of the process of building a student-driven schedule

•Final decision is based on the following: student demand, staffing allocation, teacher skillset and capacity


