**Principal Update from Russell White**

- Will be having monthly Principal Coffees to informally share ideas and communicate – next Thursday will be the first
- 590 students enrolled at International this year. Usually the school has 600 but more Juniors enrolled in Running Start this year than usual
- Students who chose Hybrid will be split into two groups. 116 students chose hybrid only. Aligned IS high school schedule with other BSD high schools to share resources especially for virtual only students.
- Prioritized courses unique to IS and retaining IS staff. Teachers really stepped up in the best interest of the students even if it made it more challenging for the teacher.
- Professional development prior to school opening to build off what was learned last Spring
- September and October measured quantity of students logging in. Now will focus on quality of the login experience.
- ASB & Executive Team working hard – 463 unique attendants at the Back to School Assembly
- Preparing transition to hybrid while keeping present remote learning going
- Future opportunities – intentionally returning to traditions we miss and imagining what we could change or add, what elements of remote learning could enhance in-person learning

**IS PTSA Survey** - 93% of the 37 people who responded are members or are planning to join the PTSA.

**Membership Update – Meribeth Nordloef-Pedersen**

- Currently, about 250 members; last year at this time, there were 456 members.
- Need one another even more this year, so all should join to support our students.
